J. Hamlett led the presentation and informed the committee that the USU recently received a donation from Alumnus Bill Imada in the amount of \$25,000 to be used to create a space for Egaming/Esport in the Games Room.

The USU is collaborating with Associated Students to create this space for the existing CSUN Esports Club and Open Rec gaming. In addition, Associated Students has agreed to contribute \$26,501 towards the total \$78,002 estimated cost of the project.

- 3. Joseph Illuminate inquired if the LED lights are portable and could be used for other purposes.
  - J. Hamlett informed the committee that the lights are portable and could be used for other events or purposes.
